GENERAL CLEANING

PRODUCT	USE
 Neutral Floor Cleaner	For use on floors, walls, woodwork and other surfaces where a pH neutral solution is desirable
 Multipurpose Cleaner	For use as a spray and wipe cleaner on any surface not affected by water. It does not contain disinfectant, therefore appropriate to use as a soapy water solution.
 Glass Cleaner	For use on glass, windows, Plexiglas, mirrors, light fixtures, stainless steel, chrome appliances, porcelain and other surfaces not affected by water.
 Laundry Liquid	For use in both top and front load washing machines. It contains no phosphates, is highly biodegradable and is particularly mild on skin.

FOOD PREPARATION AREAS

PRODUCT	USE
 Dishwashing Liquid	For use on dishes, glassware, pots and pans, floors, walls and bench tops in the kitchen to remove grease, fats, oils and food residue. This product is pH neutral making it mild on hands.
 No Rinse Sanitiser	For use in food preparation areas to provide a broad spectrum sanitisation at the final stage of the cleaning process.
 Auto-Dishwashing Liquid	For use in automatic dishwashers to leave dishes sparkling and hygienically clean. It will remove lipstick, greasy and oily food solids. NOT to be used in manual dishwashers.
 Rinse Aid	For use in dishwashers to remove spotting and streaks on dishes, cutlery and glassware and aid in the drying process.

 Sandpit Sanitiser	For use in sandpits where sandpits have been raked to remove debris and animal droppings.
